Dear Mr. Murray:

This letter confirms that you are covered under the University of Washington's Graduate Appointee Insurance Plan this Spring quarter (04/01/2011-06/30/2011).

Coverage is dependent upon continuation of eligibility criteria and payment of premiums and is reviewed monthly. If you lose coverage mid-year, you are eligible to enroll in the self-pay option through the rest of the plan year (September 30, 2011).

Coverage is available for medical, dental and vision expenses. The Medical Plan is a comprehensive major medical plan and provides reimbursement for covered medical expenses regardless of where the expenses are incurred. Benefits are paid at 60% after a \$75 per quarter deductible has been met. The maximum benefit is \$100,000 per injury or sickness each plan year (this plan year is from September 15, 2010 – September 30, 2011) and will cover injury or sickness in any country.

Included in the Medical Plan is a \$10,000 emergency evacuation to the student's home country and a \$7,500 repatriation of remains to the home country.

Dental and vision expenses are also reimbursed regardless of where the covered expense is incurred. The Dental Plan maximum is \$1,500 and the Vision Plan reimbursement is per a scheduled allowance.
